Subject: Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Distribution for PSWs in Multnomah and Washington Counties

The Department of Human Services (DHS) recognizes the role of Personal Support Workers (PSWs) providing critical health and safety services to Oregonians experiencing intellectual and developmental disabilities. Due to the current pandemic, DHS continues to supply local APD and AAA offices with PPE equipment for all PSWs across the state.

PPE distribution process

PSWs who need PPE must submit a request for PPE to the Service Employees International Union (SEIU) by completing the online web form at <https://seiu503.tfaforms.net/622> or by submitting a request to the Oregon Home Care Commission (OHCC) by emailing OHCC.CustomerRelations@dhsosha.state.or.us

The Oregon Home Care Commission verifies that the PSW is currently working for an individual. The worker self-reports their contact information, provider number, hours and requested PPE. OHCC sends an email to the worker with pick-up days and times or that their PPE will be mailed to them.
